Rate of violent crimes (per 100,000 ppl)	408 crimes	346 crimes	714 crimes
% children living in <b>poverty</b>	22%	16%	24%
% severely unaffordable or unsafe homes (monthly costs over 50% of income, no kitchen, no plumbing, or over-crowding)	18%	21%	21%
% families with limited access to a grocery store	N/A	26%	18%
Rate of <b>drug overdose</b> deaths (per 100,000 ppl)	9 deaths	12 deaths	10 deaths
